

### **NEW HAMPSHIRE SOCCER** SPORTS COMPLEX



Facility Rules 8/20.2020

**Masks or facial coverings are required** to be worn by all spectators at all times within the facility unless medical conditions, intellectual and developmental disabilities, mental health conditions or other sensory sensitivities such as autism spectrum disorder -- wearing a mask could create distress.

**Physical/social distancing is required.** All spectators are asked to keep a distance of 6' between themselves and those not from their household. The fields have been laid out and games scheduled to provide maximum space to ensure all those who wish to get back to cheering on your favorite team will be able to attend the event

**Spectators must remain in designated areas** No spectator, at any time, is allowed on the field of play including the bench area

**Players are required to wear masks** when arriving, congregated around the bench area, and leaving the field of play. **Players are not required to wear masks while playing.** 

**Dogs are not permitted in the facility**, unless the dog is recognized as a service animal defined under the ADA

Alcohol and tobacco products of any kind are strictly prohibited (includes vaping).

No BBQ's

**Physical or verbal abuse** of any kind will not be tolerated. This event is for the children of our soccer community. We will address any negativity towards a referee, player, coach or spectator with appropriate action

In this time of health and safety concerns, we all must work together to ensure we are providing a safe environment for **all** who love the game. All must recognize the risk involved and are responsible for making their own decisions to attend this event. The New Hampshire Soccer Association and the New Hampshire Soccer League will work to provide the safest environment we can and look forward to seeing all those comfortable with attending the event this weekend.

## Jamboree Rules – Weekend of 8/22-8/23

- Teams are asked not to enter onto the fields until the previous team has completely vacated the space.
- Players and coaches are to wear masks while on the sidelines. Players are not required to wear a mask while playing, but can do so if they choose.
  - Masks need to go back behind the ears and cannot be tied behind the back of the head, for safety reasons.
- Parents and spectators are to remain on the opposite side of the fields from the players and coaches at all times.
- When your team is waiting to play a match, teams will have ample space to remain distanced from other teams (see fields below)
- Upon completion of a match there will be no post-game hand-shakes. Entrances and exits to field are below.
- It is recommended to bring both home and away kits, or pinnies if needed.
- There will be no team check-ins or roster checks.
- Hand sanitizer will be provided at each team bench area. These are to stay at the fields.

### FIELD NAVIGATION

- Fields to be played on Saturday are 1A & 1B (7v7), 2A & 2B (9v9), and Fields 3, 4, and 5 on Sunday (11v11).
- For all games played on Fields 1 thru 4 players, coaches, and referees are to enter and exit by the berm only. NO PARENTS OR SPECTATORS WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE BERM.
  - The berm will have a tent "on the hill" and staff cars
- Field five will be one way traffic... the entrance will be the pathway to the left to enter the field, and the exit will be the pathway to the right to exit the fields (clockwise traffic).
- Parents are encouraged, where they can, to view games from their card away from the fields, but are welcome to sit on the opposite side of the field of the players and coaches

#### REFEREES

- All referees are required to check in on the berm. Temperatures will be checked. The event reserves the right to ask all referees to sign a liability form, which will be good for the weekend. Temp checks are before starting a game, and will be good for each day of the event respectively.
  - o IF a referee officiates on Saturday and Sunday, they will need to have temps checked both days.
- Referees are to enter and exit fields thru the pathways of the players and coaches.
- There will be no coin toss. The home team (listed first) will kick off games, or will kick off in the first half of games played in the 2x25 format.
- Visiting teams will resort to change uniforms if both teams are the same color.
