





## **Derry Soccer Club COVID Protocol for Games**

## Spectators

- 1. All spectators are required to be 6 feet away from the field at all times. Spectators from the same home may sit together, those from different homes must sit 6 feet apart. If you remove your mask at any point, you need to be a minimum of 6 ft away from all other patrons (with the exception of your immediate family).
- 2. Spectators are to remain in their cars until shortly before kick-off and return to their cars as quickly as possible at the conclusion of the game.
- 3. <u>All patrons are required to wear a mask when entering and exiting our fields.</u>

## Players

- 1. Players are to remain in their vehicles until your coach has set up cones in your warm-up area and leave the fields as quickly as possible at the conclusion of the game.
- 2. Players need to wear masks to and from the field and are required to wear masks on the sidelines when social distance of 6 feet is not possible.
- 3. Players cannot share food or drink. Contact outside of play (eg. High 5's, hugs, etc) shall be avoided at all times.

## Coaches

- 1. Coaches are required to wear masks on the field, unless proper social distancing is possible
- 2. Warm-ups can be held 30 minutes prior to the start of the game. If the field they are playing on is empty they can use half of that field, if it is occupied, they can find an empty area and warm up there. We request the coach sets up cones 6 feet apart for players to place their equipment.
- 3. If a game is on the field that they will be playing on they need to remain in their warmup area until all players and spectators have left the field.
- 4. Sidelines benches cannot be used and players should wear masks when they are unable to remain 6 feet apart. Place cones 6 feet apart for players belongings.
- 5. Health Check Take temperatures prior to the start of the game. Players with temperatures above 100.0 degrees are not allowed to play in the game. Each player needs to answer whether they have been in contact with a person with COVID-19, have a cough, have an above average temperature and whether they have lost their taste or smell. If anyone answers 'YES' to any of the questions they shall NOT be permitted to participate in any club activities.
