

COVID-19 PROTOCOL:

THE FOLLOWING PROTOCOLS NEED TO BE FOLLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN ANY ACTIVITIES ASSOCIATED WITH GRANITE STATE SOCCER.

ALL REQUIREMENTS ARE TO BE TAKEN SERIOUSLY.

COACHES:

1. BEFORE ALL TEAM ACTIVITIES, EACH INDIVIDUAL PLAYER AND/OR PARENT SHOULD ANSWER THE FOLLOWING QUESTIONS:

- A. HAVE YOU BEEN IN CONTACT WITH A PERSON WITH COVID-19?
- B. HAVE YOU HAD A COUGH?
- C. HAVE YOU HAD AN ABOVE AVERAGE TEMPERATURE?
- D. HAVE YOU OR A FAMILY MEMBER BEEN ORDERED TO QUARANTINE WITH IN THE LAST 10 DAYS?
- E. HAVE YOU BEEN QUARANTINED BY SCHOOL GUIDELINES OR PROCEDURES?
- F. HAVE YOU HAD A LOSS OF TASTE OR SMELL?

IF ANYONE ANSWERS 'YES' TO ANY OF THE QUESTIONS THE PLAYER WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO PARTICIPATE.

PARENTS:

- 1. ALTHOUGH GSS HAS SANITIZER ON SITE, PARENTS ARE ALSO RESPONSIBLE FOR PROVIDING HAND SANITIZER BEFORE AND AFTER EACH SESSION.
- 2. PARENTS NEED TO REVIEW THE PLAYER PROTOCOLS (ABOVE) WITH THEIR PLAYERS BEFORE EACH SESSION.
- 3. SPECTATORS MAY SIT TOGETHER AS LONG AS THEY MAINTAIN SOCIAL DISTANCING.
- 4. PARENTS SHOULD CHECK THEIR PLAYER'S TEMPERATURE BEFORE EVERY ACTIVITY. IF TEMPERATURE IS ABOVE 100 DEGREES, THE PLAYER NEEDS TO REMAIN HOME.
- 5. ENSURE THAT YOUR CHILD'S CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT ARE CLEAN AND/OR SANITIZED BEFORE EVERY ACTIVITY.
- 6. PARENTS NEED TO NOTIFY THE DIRECTOR OF COACHING (MLYON@GRANITESTATESOCCER.US OR 603-401-5392) IF YOUR CHILD BECOMES ILL FOR ANY REASON.
- 7. IF A PLAYER TESTS POSITIVE FOR COVID 19 THEY WILL NOT BE ABLE TO PARTICIPATE IN ACTIVITIES. 10 DAYS QUARANTINE OR PROVIDING A NEGATIVE TEST RESULT **5 DAYS AFTER TESTING POSITIVE** ARE THE CURRENT REQUIREMENTS FOR RETURN TO PLAY.

PLAYERS:

- 1. PLAYERS MUST NOT SHARE DRINKS, FOOD, OR EQUIPMENT
- 2. CONTACT OUTSIDE OF PLAY (E.G., HIGH 5'S, HUGS, ETC.) SHALL BE AVOIDED.
