CALENDAR/TASK LIST/IMPORTANT LINKS

Tips: Start early and create a detailed calendar of your town events, school events, festivals, SAT testing, Graduations, proms, coach conflicts, tournaments, and any other events that may cause conflicts with scheduling. This will assist with scheduling once scheduling starts – being proactive keeps things simpler for you and minimizes the need for game change requests.

NOTE: Team blackout dates will be done directly through GotSport for individual teams (maximum three requests). These will need to be done BEFORE initial schedule is made and sent to location managers.

League Blackout Dates: Labor Day Weekend, Columbus Day Weekend, October 1st (NHSA New England Revolution Day).

JULY

July 11th – League Registration Opens. Clubs should enter in teams / Age Brackets / Divisions placements at this time (subject to review and final placement decisions made by the league).

July 25th – NEW Location Manager contact information must be emailed to director@nhsoccerleague.com. We have a working document for all location managers, so if your location manager information has not changed since the Spring season no further action is needed. Information needed: Full name, Email address, secondary person or email, primary phone number

AUGUST

August 1st – League Registration closes at 11:59 p.m.

August 1st – Team drops due at 11:59 p.m.. After this time teams will automatically be charged the remainder of the registration fee

August 1st – Preliminary Divisions released and ongoing throughout the registration process.

August 1st – State Affiliation Fees due – All clubs need to be current with their State Affiliation Dues.

August 2nd – Final remaining league fee balance is scheduled to be automatically charged and must be paid in full. Clubs will not be able to play games unless paid in full.

August 5th – Schedule to location Managers for scheduling of home games – The clubs will be able to see home and away games at this time and will be able to reach out to other location managers to coordinate games. Games can be moved to any day of the week if both clubs agree.

August 9th – Schedule due back from location managers – All home games should be scheduled at this time and conflicts with opposing teams worked out.

August 12th – Schedule provided to Referee Assignor and Final schedule released to the public. Any game changes after this date will need to be done by using a game change form and paying the appropriate fee.

August 19th – Rosters due to the State – When submitting Rosters, the teams should be complete and ready. Players can be added up to roster freeze date. Only players with verified birth certificates in GotSport will be generated.

August 19th – Clubs invoiced state and league fees. Payments due upon receipt of invoices. Clubs will not be able to play games until all invoices and fees are paid (including any fees or sanctions due from Spring season).

August 26th – Season Starts – Match week 1 weekend

SEPTEMBER

September 2nd-5th – Labor Day Weekend – No matches

September 9th – Match Week 2 weekend

September 16th – Match Week 3 weekend

September 21st – Roster Freeze – No roster changes other than coaches will be accepted after this date.

September 23rd – Match Week 4 weekend

September 30th – Match Week 5 weekend

OCTOBER

October 1st – Automatic Blackout date – Fall NHSA New England Revolution Day – Revs play at 1:00, NHSA teams can play under the lights.

October 7th-10th – Columbus Day Weekend – No matches

October 14th – Match Week 6 weekend

October 21st – Match Week 7 weekend

October 28th – Playoffs. Playoffs will occur with games on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday. Games are scheduled to occur at the NHSA Soccer Complex in Pembroke, NH (subject to change with notice).
