League Blackout Dates: Labor Day Weekend, Columbus Day Weekend

JULY

July 26th – League Registration Opens. Clubs should enter in teams / Age Brackets / Divisions placements at this time (subject to review and final placement decisions made by the league).

July 31st – New Location Manager contact information should be emailed to director@nhsoccerleague.com. We have a working document for all location managers, so if your club location manager information has not changed since the Spring season no further action is needed. Information needed: Full name, Email address, secondary person or email, primary phone number. The Location Manager is the person responsible for scheduling matches for the club.

AUGUST

August 11th – League Registration closes at 11:59 p.m.

August 11th – Team drops due at 11:59 p.m. After this time teams will automatically be charged the remainder of the registration fee

August 11th – State Affiliation Fees due – All clubs need to be current with their State Affiliation Dues.

August 11th – Final remaining league fee balance is scheduled to be automatically charged and must be paid in full. Clubs will not be able to play games unless paid in full. No Refunds after this date.

August 13th – Divisions Released

August 16th – Schedule to location Managers for scheduling of home games – The clubs will be able to see home and away games at this time and will be able to reach out to other location managers to coordinate games. Games can be moved to any day of the week if both clubs agree.

August 21st – Schedule due back from location managers – All home games should be scheduled at this time and conflicts with opposing teams worked out.

August 22nd – Schedule provided to Referee Assignor and Final schedule released to the public. Any game changes from this date forward will need to be done by using a game change form and paying the appropriate fee.



SEPTEMBER

September 4th – Rosters due to the State – When submitting Rosters, the teams should be complete and ready. Players can be added up to roster freeze date. Only players with verified birth certificates in GotSport will be generated. Rosters must include a current photo and uniform number for each player.

September 7th – Season Starts – Match week 1 weekend

September 14th – Match Week 2 weekend

September 21st – Match Week 3 weekend

September 25th –Roster Freeze – No roster changes other than coaches will be accepted after this date.

September 28th – Match Week 4 weekend

OCTOBER

October 5th – Match Week 5 weekend

October 12th-14th – **Optional Match Week – Columbus Day weekend – League will not schedule matches**

October 19th – Match Week 6 weekend

October 26th – Match Week 7 weekend

NOVEMBER

***November 1st-3rd** - Playoffs. Playoffs will occur with games on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday. Games are scheduled to occur at the NHSA Soccer Complex in Pembroke, NH (subject to change with notice).

* In the event of excessive inclement weather, the playoff weekend may be adjusted to November 8th-10th if necessary

Tips: Start early and create a detailed calendar of your town events, school events, festivals, SAT testing, Graduations, proms, coach conflicts, tournaments, and any other events that may cause conflicts with scheduling. This will assist with scheduling once the scheduling period starts – being proactive keeps things simpler for you and minimizes the need for game change requests and reduces costs. Make sure your club location manager is up to date.

NOTE: Team blackout dates will be done directly through GotSport for individual teams. If you have a date that a team is unavailable to play a match, teams can change dates in the location manager scheduling window before the schedule goes final, so communicate team specific requests with your club's location managers.
