CALENDAR/TASK LIST/IMPORTANT LINKS

Tips: Start early and create a detailed calendar of your town events, school events, festivals, SAT testing, Graduations, proms, coach conflicts, tournaments, and any other events that may cause conflicts with scheduling. This will assist with scheduling once scheduling starts – being proactive keeps things simpler for you and minimizes the need for game change requests. Make sure your club location manager is up to date.

NOTE: Team blackout dates will be done directly through GotSport for individual teams. These will need to be done BEFORE initial schedule is made and sent to location managers.

League Blackout Dates: April 1st (NHSA New England Revolution Day).

FEBRUARY

February 13th – League Registration Opens. Clubs should enter in teams / Age Brackets / Requested Division placements at this time (subject to review and final placement decisions made by the league).

****GotSport is currently down and registration will be back online shortly.**

MARCH

March 8th – NEW Location Manager contact information must be emailed to director@nhsoccerleague.com. We have a working document for all location managers, so if your location manager information has not changed since the Fall season no further action is needed. Information needed: Full name, Email address, secondary person or email, primary phone number.

March 15th – League Registration closes at 11:59 p.m. – Every team that is registered after this date will be charged a fee of \$100 – Late registrations may not be accepted.

March 20th – Team drops due by 11:59 p.m. After this time teams will automatically be charged the remainder of the registration fee

March 20th – Preliminary Divisions released and ongoing throughout the registration process.

March 20th – State Affiliation Fees due – All clubs need to be current with their State Affiliation Dues.

March 21st – Final remaining league fee balance is scheduled to be automatically charged and must be paid in full. Clubs will not be able to play games unless paid in full.

March 22nd – Final Divisions Released



March 24th – Schedule to location Managers for scheduling of home games – The clubs will be able to see home and away games at this time and will be able to reach out to other location managers to coordinate games. Games can be moved to any day of the week if both clubs agree.

March 28th – Schedule due back from location managers – All home games should be scheduled at this time and conflicts with opposing teams worked out.

March 31st – Schedule provided to Referee Assignor and Final schedule released to the public. Any game changes after this date will need to be done by using a game change form and paying the appropriate fee.

APRIL

April 1st – Automatic Blackout date – Spring NHSA New England Revolution Day – Revs play at 7:30 p.m. NHSA teams can play before the game. Contact nhadmin@soccernh.org for more information.

April 7th – Rosters due to the State – When submitting Rosters, the teams should be complete and ready. Players can be added up to roster freeze date. Only players with verified birth certificates in GotSport will be generated.

April 14th – Season Starts – Match week 1 weekend

April 21st – Match Week 2 weekend

April 28th – Match Week 3 weekend

MAY

May 3rd – Roster Freeze – No roster changes other than coaches will be accepted after this date.

May 5th – Match Week 4 weekend

May 12th – Match Week 5 weekend

May 19th – Match Week 6 weekend

May 26th – Optional Match Week – Memorial Day weekend – **League will not schedule matches**

JUNE

June 2nd – Match Week 7 weekend

June 9th – Match Week 8 weekend

June 16th – Playoffs. Playoffs will occur with games on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday. Games are scheduled to occur at the NHSA Soccer Complex in Pembroke, NH (subject to change with notice).
