## **Masks**

Anyone who is involved in a sport, club, or activity is expected to wear a mask at all times while indoors, and outdoors when social distancing of six-feet or more is not possible (exceptions apply to sporting games and practices - see Sports-Specific Guidance for more

information). Student-athletes and coaches will wear a mask from the time they arrive at a practice or game until they make it to a field and can appropriately socially distance.

Any spectator watching a game or practice from the bleachers must wear a mask at all times. In other locations, masks are required only when social distancing of at least six feet is not possible. Those who refuse to wear a mask will not be allowed entry/asked to leave.

## **Portable Toilets**

Two portable toilets will be placed at all locations in which sporting events will take place. These locations include Stadium Field, Stone Field, Community Field, and Humiston Field.

At Stadium Field, male and female student-athletes will use the assigned bathroom facility. Portable toilets will be used by spectators and the visiting team.

## **Spectators**

Spectators will be permitted to attend home games for the spring sports season. Spectators will wear masks and follow other district guidelines while in bleachers or other spaces used for sitting/congregating to watch the game. Those who do not follow the district's guidance will be asked to leave.

Anyone flagged to have symptoms of COVID-19 may be asked to leave the event they are at. Please do not attend a district event if you are showing symptoms of COVID-19 or if you have recently tested positive for COVID-19.

All spectators will abide by all guidance in this document and in the Reopening Framework. Those who do not abide by the guidance will be asked to leave.

## EXPECTATIONS FOR COACHES/ADVISORS

Coaches and advisors will ensure that all student-athletes adhere to proper mask-wearing procedures and other guidelines in the district's Reopening Framework. Coaches and advisors will create opportunities for socially distanced water and mask breaks.

During games, practices, clubs, and other activities, coaches and advisors should designate areas for student-athletes/learners to place their backpacks, equipment, etc.

Prior to any game, scrimmage, or other interaction with a team or people from outside the Jaffrey-Rindge Cooperative School District, coaches and advisors will confirm that everyone involved has participated in a COVID-19 screening process and that no one is experiencing any symptoms.

Coaches will be responsible for handling all training and other equipment, sanitizing all practice areas and equipment used, cleaning the areas that were designated for bags and equipment, wiping down door handles and often touched.

## SPORTS-SPECIFIC CRITERIA

### Soccer

Players will be expected to keep their masks with them at all times so that they can be worn when social distancing of at least six feet is not possible. Student-athletes will not need to wear masks while competing.
