





Thank you for visiting the Bean Fields in Amherst, NH and helping us to keep our community healthy during this time of COVID-19.

## Facility:

- Please adhere to all signs. Gates to fields are marked either entrance only or exit only (see below map) and NO PETS ALLOWED
- No tailgating or congregating in the parking area
- Porta-toilets are available in the parking lot and by the playground, use at your own risk
- > Sanitizer stations are available at the two entrances to the fields, please have all players and spectators use prior to entering the fields
- > Trash barrels are located at gates, please do not leave any trash on the fields
- > Temperatures and health checks are requested to be completed prior to arriving to the fields

## **Spectators:**

- Masks All patrons are required to wear a mask or facial covering at the facility at all times, including entering and exiting our fields and while watching games unless medical conditions, intellectual and developmental disabilities, mental health conditions or other sensory sensitivities such as autism spectrum disorder -- wearing a mask could create distress.
- Transition Between Games Spectators are asked to wait in their cars until the spectator area of the prior game clears before entering field and setting up to watch their game. At the conclusion of your game please clear the spectator areas quickly for next game.
- Sideline Spacing Spectators must sit on the opposite side of field as their teams bench at least 6 feet from the line of play. A spectator line (strictly enforced) will be painted from the touchline. All spectators are expected to observe good social distancing. Families can sit together but all other spectators should be at last 6ft apart. Spectators must remain in designated areas. No spectator, at any time, is allowed on the field of play including the bench area unless called upon.

## Players:

- Masks Players are required to wear masks when arriving, congregated around the bench area and sideline, and leaving the field of play. Players are not required to wear masks while on the field of play.
- > Transition Between Games Players are to remain in their vehicle until your coach has set up cones in your warm-up area. Please leave the fields as quickly as possible at the conclusion of the game.
- ➤ Health Management Contact outside of play (eg. High 5's, hugs, team huddles, etc.) shall be avoided at all times. Players cannot share food or drink.

## Coaches:

- Masks Coaches are required to wear mask or face covering on the field at all times
- Transition Between Games Warm-ups can be held 30 minutes prior to the start of the game. If the field they are playing on is empty they can use half of that field, if it is occupied, they can find an empty area and warm up there. If a game is on the field that they will be playing on they need to remain in their warmup area until all players and spectators have left the field.
- > Sideline Spacing Dots (6ft apart) will be painted on each benches sideline for each player to place their personal belongs and for breaks.
- ➤ Health Management Beyond the of the field sanitizer prior to entering the field, coaches need to supply their own hand sanitizer for their team. Hands should be sanitized at the beginning, break and end of games. Players temperature must be taken prior to the start of the game. Players with temperatures above 100.0 degrees are not allowed to play in the game. Each player needs to answer whether they have been in contact with a person with COVID-19, have a cough, have an above average temperature and whether they have lost their taste or smell. If anyone answers 'YES' to any of the questions they shall NOT be permitted to participate in any club activities.

Physical or verbal abuse of any kind will not be tolerated. We will address any negativity towards a referee, player, coach or spectator with appropriate action and have the right to ask a person to leave the complex.
